

Snakes and Ladders: How to Play

Objective of the Game

Be the first player to reach the final square by skillfully navigating the board, avoiding the snakes, and climbing the ladders!

Players: Number of Participants and Choosing Tokens

- Players Needed: 2–4 players can join in the game.
- **Choosing Tokens**: Each player selects a unique token or marker to represent them on the game board, making it easy to track progress.

Game Setup: Preparing to Play Snakes and Ladders

TAAB ARCADE

- 1. **Starting Position**: Place all tokens on square 1, which is the starting point.
- 2. **Determine Play Order**: Have each player roll the dice once to decide who goes first; the player with the highest roll starts, with turns proceeding clockwise.

Rules of Play: How to Take Your Turn in Snakes and Ladders

- 1. **Roll the Dice and Move Forward**: On your turn, roll the dice and advance your token forward by the number shown on the dice.
- 2. **Climb the Ladders**: If you land on a square with the bottom of a ladder, you immediately move up to the square at the top of the ladder.
- 3. **Avoid the Snakes**: If you land on a square with a snake's head, slide down to the square at the tail of the snake.
- 4. **Exact Roll Needed to Reach the Final Square**: To win, you need to roll the exact number to reach the final square. If you roll a number higher than needed, you "bounce back" the extra steps in the opposite direction.





Special Rules for Snakes and Ladders

- Multiple Players on the Same Square: If players land on the same square, it's perfectly fine! There is no penalty or advantage for landing on an occupied square.
- **Winning the Game**: The first player to reach the final square is the winner and can claim victory!
